CANCELLATION NOTICE OF BLOOMSBURG NATIONALS AUTO SHOW & SWAP MEET SCHEDULED FOR AUGUST 13-15, 2021

The Team at Bloomsburg Nationals has made the difficult decision to not host the annual Bloomsburg Nationals Auto Show and Swap Meet, scheduled for August 13-15, 2021, at the Bloomsburg Fairgrounds as we were not able to come to a mutual contractual agreement for the rental of the grounds that supported all entities involved while still generating funds for the local charities Bloomsburg Nationals supported. The decision to not host the show was not an easy decision to make. During the time the show was promoted by the Team at Bloomsburg Nationals, proceeds were donated to various local charities: Ronald McDonald House of Danville, EOS Therapeutic Riding Center in Buckhorn, Camp Victory in Millville, The Women's Center, Inc., in Bloomsburg, Children's Dyslexia Center in Bloomsburg and Beyond Violence, Inc., in Berwick. Many other local not-for-profits also received funding generated by our show. It was satisfying to see the motels, hotels and local restaurants all busy during the second weekend in August as our show supported local businesses. Many articles by car enthusiasts wrote about our show and were published in various magazines and editorials. We would like to thank those that helped make our show grow and become an asset to the Town of Bloomsburg.
